Fast Track Article

For short scientific papers (max. 4 pages).

The purpose of Fast Track is to provide a channel to guarantee fast publication for short scientific papers (max. 4 pages) characterized by their concision and originality: fast peer-review, fast production of accepted manuscripts and immediate open access publication within 2 months from submission.

Fast Track fee on acceptance of the article: **EUR 350** (plus VAT, if applicable).

Open Access Article

For regular research papers (no limitation in length).

Articles are subject to independent peer-review: upon acceptance of their research papers authors can decide to make use of the open access publication option.

Article Publication Charge (APC) on acceptance of the article: **EUR 1200** (plus VAT, if applicable).
