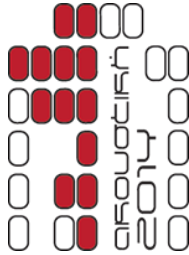


7th Hellenic National Conference "ACOUSTICS 2014"



The Hellenic Institute of Acoustics (HELINA) organizes the biennial National Conference of Acoustics to be held in Thessaloniki, the 2nd largest city of Greece on **20 and 21 October 2014**. The Conference is organized by the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, which has a large group of professors working on different aspects of Acoustics. Thessaloniki has already hosted the 2nd National Conference on Acoustics which was held in 2004. The logo of this year conference depicts in artistic design the "White Tower" which is the symbol of Thessaloniki.

The purpose of the conference is to bring together Greek acousticians to present and discuss recent developments in all the fields of acoustics and its applications. A large number of papers are customarily presented by young acousticians who form a dynamic group of scientists in Greece. The commercial sector is also well represented through an exhibition of acoustical products and services.

This year, a total of 50 papers will be presented in the Conference covering all aspects of acoustics and the official language of the presentations will be Greek.
