

Important Dates:

- October 1st, 2014: start of application process (Phase 1)
- February 1st, 2015: end of application process (Phase 1)
- February 2nd, 2015: start of registration process (Phase 2)
- April 1st, 2015: end of registration process (Phase 2)
- May 11th-15th, 2015: “Passive Imaging and monitoring in wave physics: from seismology to ultrasound” workshop in Cargese (Corsica).

Registration procedure

The individual registration to the “Passive Imaging and monitoring in wave physics: from seismology to ultrasound” workshop (Cargese, May 11th-15th, 2015) is a two-step procedure involving:

- 1- The application process.
- 2- The registration process.

During phase 1, the applicants are required to fill in an application form that is submitted to the scientific committee. The application can be found at:

Applicants will be selected upon their research interest, their academic level (PhD students, Post-docs, Research Associate...), and, eventually, their publication list. Applicants are encouraged to present a poster (Wednesday afternoon (May, 13th) is classically devoted to poster sessions).

The final selection of applicants will be made according to a certain number of criteria:

- young researchers will be given top priority.
- an appropriate balance will be found between the different research fields covered by the workshop: Ocean Acoustics, Geophysics, Ultrasonics and Mathematical Physics.

After confirmation of their selection, all applicants have to complete the registration process (phase 2). Information such that accompanying person(s), accommodation in Cargese, personal diet, travel information (from and to the Ajaccio airport) will then be registered. Payment of registration fees will also be required (deadline April 1st, 2015).

Registration fees are 600 euros. Note that registration fees are not paid until your application (Phase 1) has been approved.

Registration fees include accommodation, on a shared room basis, in Cargese [from Sunday night (May 10th) to Saturday morning (May, 15th)], lunches at the Institute, coffee breaks, bus transportation from Ajaccio airport to Cargese (round-trip) and a BBQ on Thursday evening (May, 14th) at the Institute.

Housing, for the duration of the course only, will be arranged by the staff of the Institute following, as much as possible, your preferences. Depending on the school size, demands for single rooms or accompanying persons can be satisfied upon prior acceptance of organizers. Extra fare will then have to be paid on site.
