

Death of Derek Sugden

Distinguished structural engineer and acoustician Derek Sugden, an Honorary Fellow of the IOA and a recipient of its Engineering Medal, has died aged 91. A founding partner of Arup Associates in 1963, he went on to work on such acclaimed projects as the Snape Maltings concert hall in Suffolk; the Buxton and Glyndebourne opera houses; and the Theatre Royal, Glasgow.
