

Euronoise 2018 Crete

Preparations for the EURONOISE 2018 are well under-way. The Organizing Committee has received over 650 abstracts for oral or poster presentations including invited and contributed papers. 55 structured sessions have been scheduled and the Conference is expected to be a great success, following the tradition of the previous EURONOISE Conferences. Submissions have been received from all parts of the world, which is an indication of the great interest that the Conference has received among the acousticians around the globe. The authors of accepted papers have already been notified on the acceptance of their work. The conference registration as well as the full paper submission procedure is open. The Conference program will be announced in the beginning of May.

Due to the fact that the Conference period falls within the touristic season in Crete, the participants are advised to proceed with lodging arrangements at their earliest convenience.

An Exhibition, addressing European providers of acoustic products, services and information will be hosted during the Conference. There is already a great interest about the exhibition and most of the available booths have already been reserved. As there are still booths available, the interesting companies are advised to visit the Conference site for information and for booking a booth.

The Organizing Committee is working towards the preparation of the parallel scientific and social events. Of particular interest among the social events are the three scheduled side-seeing tours the cost of which is included in the participation fees of the participants and registered accompanying persons. The participants upon registration will be asked to indicate the tour they wish to attend. As there is a limitation in the available seats for each tour, the booking of the tour will be made on a first-come first-served basis. Interested participants are advised to visit the conference site (www.euronoise2018.eu) for information on the side-seeing tours each one dedicated to a different area of Crete (Lasithi, Heraklion and Rethymnon).

The Board and Executive Council meetings of EAA will be held at the Conference venue on Saturday, May 26th. On Sunday, May 27th the General Assembly of EAA will also be held at the same site. EAA Technical Committees meetings will be scheduled during the Conference period, the final event of which will be the Board Meeting of the International Commission for Acoustics already scheduled for Thursday, May 31st.

The Boards of the EAA and the Hellenic Institute of Acoustics are looking forward to welcoming the acoustics community of the whole world in Crete, for another interesting Conference organized in Europe on behalf of EAA.
